**Replacing the Parish Hall Floor.** The Diocese has now approved plans to replace the floor in the Parish Hall. The work will take place over the summer holidays and the Hall will be closed for 3 weeks from Monday 30<sup>th</sup> July to Sunday 19 August. A lot of work has been done to put together a plan to use Parish Volunteers as much as we can to help keep down costs, nevertheless it will still cost £12,000. To help pay for the new floor the Parish is grateful for a grant of £4,500 from 'The Guild of Our Lady of Ransom, a Charity founded in 1887 to help Parishes in England and Wales. Please remember the 'Ransomers' in your prayers offering special thanks for their generosity. There will be a list for Volunteers on the noticeboard in the church entrance showing what help is needed and when. If you can help move furniture, strip out the old floor and repaint the hall please consider booking some of your time to help with this work.

**Parish Accounts 2017/18** The Parish Finance Committee met on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> April and signed off the 2017/18 Accounts which were then submitted to the Diocese, well ahead of time. The accounts are now be subject to inspection and review by the Diocese and we may be selected for Audit. Once the Accounts are approved by the Diocese we will be able to publish them to the Parish; Hopefully this will be in June.

**Regina Caeli Prayer:** This prayer will be recited before the 6:30pm and 8am Mass each week and after the 11am Mass on Sundays. It will also be recited before each weekday Mass. The Regina Caeli is a prayer in honour of Our Lady – Mary, the mother of Jesus Christ. Translated from Latin, it means Queen of Heaven. It is traditionally prayed at the end of each day. During Eastertide – from Easter Night to Pentecost – it is prayed three times a day in place of the Angelus, at 6.00am, 12.00 noon and 6.00pm.
