Letter from Bishop Marcus to the Parishioners of St Aelred's Parish, Harrogate: *".....there is no priest for me to appoint as a resident priest. Therefore I have appointed Canon James Callaghan who will be the new PP of St Robert's from the summer, to take responsibility for the spiritual and pastoral care of St Aelred's Parish.....some changes shall need to be made to the provision and times of Masses at St Aelred's. Any such changes will be decided up at a local level and take into consideration the needs of the parishes and parishioners in Harrogate, and the health and welfare of their clergy".* The full content of the Bishop's letter is available at the back of the church.
